If you have or will be completing your Certification in Alcohol & Drug Counseling (CADC) or Certified Addictions Treatment Counseling (CATC) program soon we would like to hear from you!

Or

if you have a bachelor's degree in human services, Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, Psychology or related field and some experience working with people with substance use disorders, we would like to hear from you!

Or

If you have training as a Community Health Worker and have worked in behavioral health, we would like to hear from you!

Community Health Worker/Substance Use Navigator role includes:

- Brief assessment of need and readiness for change, intervention, referral; and follow-up for inpatients, emergency department patients and outpatients.
 - Serve as liaison between Medical Center and public and private organizations serving persons with substance use disorders /chemical dependency to improve coordination of care.
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- Receives hospital and community referrals and meets with patient in-person or by phone before they leave the hospital or Emergency Department whenever possible to explain the Navigation program.
 - Ensures that patient is aware of and has follow-up appointments with physician and ancillary providers and arrange appointments as needed. Monitors if follow-up appointments have been successful.
